	Use your ears to find something quiet.
Use your eyes to find something shaped like a triangle.	Use your ears to find something musical.
Use your fingers to find something soft.	Use your nose to find something clean.
Use your fingers to find something bumpy.	
Use your fingers to find something smooth.	Use your nose to find something stinky.

Answers can vary, and you might have a different answer the next time you visit!
